AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14 OF ORDINANCE NO. A-275 OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL *W. P. ...* OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 14 of Ordinance No. A-275, passed by the City Council of the City of Conway, Arkansas on April 22, 1952, is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

"SECTION 14. (a) Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate or permit, suffer or allow anyone under their or its direction or control to violate Sections Four (4), Five (5), Seven (7) Eight (8) or Ten (10) of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined by a fine of not less than twenty-five cents (25¢) nor more than Five Dollars (\$5.00), for each offense.

"(b) Any person, firm or corporation who shall aid, abet or assist in the violation of the provisions of said sections shall, upon conviction, be punishable by a fine of not less than twenty-five cents (25¢) nor more than Five Dollars (\$5.00), for each offense. Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate or permit, suffer or allow anyone under their or its direction or control to violate Section Eleven (11) of said Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punishable by a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each offense. Any person, firm or corporation who shall aid, abet or assist in the violation of the provisions of Section Eleven (11) shall, upon conviction, be punishable by a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each offense."

SECTION 2. This ordinance, being necessary for the immediate protection of the public and for the preservation of the peace, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
