

ORDINANCE NO. 0-75-7

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS; DECLARING SUCH TERRITORY TO BE A PART OF SAID CITY; ASSIGNING SUCH TERRITORY TO A WARD; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

WHEREAS, Enterprise Sales, Inc. is the owner of the hereinafter described territory; and did duly petition the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas for an Order annexing the said territory to the City of Conway, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, after proceedings being had upon notice by publication, all as provided by and in accordance with the laws of the State of Arkansas, the Judge of the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas did, on February 3rd, 1975 enter an Order annexing such lands to said City:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Conway, Arkansas does hereby accept the hereinafter described territory, annexed to said City by Order of the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas, heretofore entered on February 3rd, 1975, said territory being described as follows, to-wit:

The West Half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Three (3), Township Five (5) North, Range Fourteen (14) West, containing Eighty (80) acres, more or less.

And that said lands and territory be, and the same hereby are, accepted by and declared to be a part of the City of Conway, Faulkner County, Arkansas.

SECTION 2. The lands hereinabove described are hereby assigned to and shall constitute a part of Ward Three (3) of the City of Conway, Arkansas.

SECTION 3. It is ascertained and declared that it is necessary for the protection and preservation of the public health and safety that the foregoing ordinance be passed and adopted; that an emergency exists and this ordinance shall take effect

and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
