

WHEREAS, Anthony Halter, being the owner in fee simple of the hereinafter described lands, did petition the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas, for an order annexing said lands and territory to the City of Conway, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, after proceedings being had upon notice by publication, all as provided by law and in accordance with the laws of Arkansas, the Judge of the said County Court did, on 16 day of March, 1977 enter his order of annexation to said City of the hereinafter described lands:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of Conway, Arkansas, does hereby accept the hereinafter described lands and territory annexed to said City by order of the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas, heretofore entered on March 16, 1977 said territory being described as follows: to-wit:

Part of the $W\frac{1}{2}$, $SE\frac{1}{4}$, of Section 13, T5N, R14W, Faulkner County, Arkansas, described as follows: Begin at the SW corner of said $W\frac{1}{2}$, $SE\frac{1}{4}$; thence N-0-46-03-E, 2,333.38 feet, to the South right of way of State Highway #286 for a point of beginning, thence along said right of way S-64-57-42-E 462.84 feet; thence S-59-15-04-E 100.50 feet; thence S-64-57-42-E 100.00 feet; thence S-70-40-20-E 100.50 feet; thence S-65-00-20-E 667.48 feet; thence leaving said right of way S-0-54-55-W 419.45 feet; thence S-1-01-33-W 180.55 feet; thence in a Northwestwardly direction at the same angle up State Highway #286 to the west boundary line of said $W\frac{1}{2}$, $SE\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, T5N, R14W, thence N-89-22-56-W to the right of way of said State Highway #286 to the point of beginning.

and that said lands and territory be, and the same hereby are, declared to be a part of the City of Conway, Faulkner County, Arkansas.

SECTION 2. It is ascertained and declared that it is necessary for the protection and preservation of the public health and safety that the foregoing ordinance be passed and adopted; that an emergency exists; that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication;
