

ORDINANCE NO. 79-17

WHEREAS, Robert Ott, Richard W. Longing, Lemoin E. Smith and Alice M. Smith, are the owners of the hereinafter described lands, did petition the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas for an Order annexing said lands and territory to the City of Conway, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, after proceeding being had upon Notice by publication, all as provided by law and in accordance with the laws of the State of Arkansas, the Judge of the said County Court did, on the 6th day of March, 1979, enter his order of annexation to said City of the hereinafter described lands:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. That the City Council of Conway, Arkansas, does hereby accept the hereinafter described lands and territory, annexed to said City by order of the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas, heretofore entered on the 6th day of March, 1979, said territory being described as follows, to-wit:

Being a part of the N $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 2, T5N, R14W, Faulkner Co., Ark. and described as beginning at the SE Corner of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; thence running North 0 deg. 4 min. 24 sec. West 80 ft.; thence West 406 ft.; thence North 0 deg. 4 min. 24 sec. West 1168.69 ft. to the South right of way line of the railroad; thence along said South right of way South 65 deg. 47 min. East 2222.56 ft. to a point 1028 ft. West of the East line of said N $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ; thence running parallel with said East line South 0 deg. 32 min. 32 sec. West 337.03 ft. to the South line of said N $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ; thence West 1616 ft. to the point of beginning, containing 36.44 acres, more or less, reserving all roadways, public or private, which might be thereon.


and that said lands and territory be, and the same hereby are declared to be a part of the City of Conway, Faulkner County, Arkansas.

2. That it is ascertained and declared that it is necessary for the protection and preservation of the public health and safety that the foregoing ordinance be passed and adopted; that an emergency exists; that this ordinance shall take effect and


be in force from and after its passage and publication.
