AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS: DECLARING SUCH TERRITORY TO BE A PART OF SAID CITY: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY: AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, certain property owners lying adjacent to the city limits of Conway, Arkansas, did petition the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas, for an order annexing the hereinafter described territory to said city; and

WHEREAS, after proceedings being had upon notice by publication, all as provided by and in accordance with the laws of the State of Arkansas, the judge of the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas, did, on August 3, 1982, enter his order of annexation to said city of the hereinafter described lands:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the City Council of Conway, Arkansas, does hereby accept the hereinafter described territory, annexed to said city by order of the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas, heretofore entered on August 3, 1982, said territory being described as follows, to-wit:

The North Half ($N\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 31, Township 6 North, Range 13 West, containing 60 acres, more or less, and excepting that portion which has previously been accepted by the City which is more particularly described as follows: All lands South of the existing county road and West of a line described as beginning 1128.0' West and 561.0' South of the NE corner of said $N\frac{1}{2}$ $NW\frac{1}{4}$ and run thence South 759' to the South boundary of the $N\frac{1}{2}$ of the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31, T6N, R13W, containing 20 acres, more or less.

And that the said above described lands and territory be, and the same hereby are, declared to be a part of the City of Conway, Faulkner County, Arkansas.
