

ORDINANCE NO.

0-83-10

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS: DECLARING SUCH TERRITORY TO BE A PART OF SAID CITY: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY: AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, a certain property owner lying adjacent to the city of Conway, Arkansas, did petition the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas, for an order annexing the hereinafter described territory to said city; and

WHEREAS, after proceedings being had upon notice by publication, all as provided by and in accordance with the laws of the State of Arkansas, the judge of the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas, did, on December 16, 1982, enter his order of annexation to said city of the hereinafter described lands:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION I: That the City Council of Conway, Arkansas, does hereby accept the hereinafter described territory, annexed to said city by order of the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas, heretofore entered on December 16, 1982, said territory being described as follows, to-wit:

Part of the SE Corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, Township 5 North of the Base Line in Range 13 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, and containing 2 acres, more or less; more particularly described as follows: Begin at the SE Corner of the said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, said Section, Township and Range, and run North 450 feet to the point of beginning of the herein described Two (2) acre tract; running thence North 210 feet along the East line of the said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; thence West 420 feet; thence South 210 feet; thence East 420 feet to the point of beginning of the herein described two (2) acre tract.

And that the said above described lands and territory be, and the same hereby are, declared to be a part of the City of Conway, Faulkner County, Arkansas.
