

ORDINANCE NO. 0-87-42

AN ORDINANCE NAMING TWO STREETS; DECLARING AM EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the street described below shall be named "Amity Road":

The street that parallels Interstate 40 on the east side, beginning at the southernmost exit from I-40 within the Conway City limits, more particularly at State Highways 65B and 286, and running south between I-40 and the East Industrial Park and then curving to run in an easterly direction to the city limits.

SECTION 2: That the street described below shall be named "Reedy Road":


The street that begins on the northern end at State Highway 60 (Prince Street) immediately south of Shady Valley Subdivision and runs generally south along the western boundary of the Conway Country Club, intersecting College Avenue and continuing south to the city limits.

SECTION 3: That all ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 4: That this ordinance is necessary for the protection of the public peace, health and safety and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.


