

ORDINANCE NO. 0-94-08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JANUARY 1, 1994 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 1994, AND PROVIDING THAT THE SEVERAL AMOUNTS STATED IN THE BUDGET DOCUMENT AS ADOPTED EXPENDITURES SHALL BE AMENDED FOR THE VARIOUS FUNCTIONS AND ACTIVITIES SPECIFIED IN SAID DOCUMENT; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Conway, Arkansas, has submitted to the City Council amendments to the budget for the fiscal year 1994;

WHEREAS, the Police Department is in need of special rain gear for the entire force at an approximate cost of \$6,000 for 70 suits; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department is also in need of special duty uniforms for nine officers at an approximate cost of \$1,600; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department is also in need of six patrol vehicles purchased from State Contract at a total approximate cost of \$92,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The sum of \$99,600 is hereby transferred from account 51-106-900 to the Police Department Budget in order to fund the above reference purchases.

SECTION 2. That from the effective date of the budget, to wit: January 1, 1994, the several amounts as stated therein as adopted expenditures shall be and are hereby amended to reflect this amendment to the specified departments therein.


SECTION 3. The Mayor is directed to cause the proper accounting entries to be made in the books and records of the City so as to reflect the amendments for the aforesaid fiscal year.

SECTION 4. That all ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance is necessary for the protection of the public peace, health and safety and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.


