

ORDINANCE NO. ~~094~~1-8

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: The City of Conway, Arkansas, hereby accepts the hereinafter described territory, annexed to said City by order of the County Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas, heretofore entered on the 23rd day of March, **1994**, and said territory being situated in Faulkner County, Arkansas, shall be a part of the City of Conway and shall be zoned R-1 and described as follows:

Part of the Northeast **1/4**, Southeast **1/4** Section **17**, T5N, R13W, described as follows: Begin at a point **390** feet South and **1248** feet Southeasterly of the Northwest Corner of said Northeast **1/4**, Southeast **1/4**, thence **185** feet to the Section Line, thence North 390 feet along Section Line, thence Northwesterly **196.2** feet thence South **422.6** feet parallel with East Section Line to the point of beginning containing **1.66** acres more or less. This tract subject to Highway #286 easement on the North side and 25 feet road easement on Mayor Lane on the East side


and that said above-described lands and territory be, and the same hereby are, declared to be a part of the City of Conway, Faulkner County, Arkansas.

SECTION 2: From and after this date, the inhabitants residing within and upon the hereinabove described lands and territory shall have and enjoy all the rights and privileges of, and be subject to all the laws, rules, ordinances, limitations, and regulations imposed upon the inhabitants within the original limits of said City of Conway, Arkansas, and for voting purposes, said lands are hereby assigned to and designated as a part of Ward **4** of the City of Conway, Arkansas.

SECTION 3: It is hereby ascertained and declared that it is necessary for the protection and preservation of the public health and safety that the foregoing ordinance be passed and adopted; that an emergency exists; and that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.


