TO: MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL

The Zoning and Planning Committee recommends a DO-PASS on the Resolution made at the February 13, 1973, meeting of the City Council on the Enterprise Sales Company, Inc. property PROVIDED that the following steps are taken by the owner.

1. A profile drawing be made of the property to show proper drainage.
2. That the proposed East-West street make connection with Oak Forrest Subdivision which allows a smooth flow of traffic.
3. A 50-foot dedication for a street North-South somewhere in the middle of the 1320 foot property so as to make proper connections to the property which lies North and South of the said property.
4. Where the property (480 feet) touches the Country Club road, there must be an additional 10-foot dedication on the East side of the street.

All of the above must be complied with if the City is to grow in a proper and healthy manner.





BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Conway, Arkansas:




