

RESOLUTION R-78-64

WHEREAS, the CATV franchise has for many years been reserved for the people of Conway as a city owned utility, and

WHEREAS, the services of cable television are needed and desired by the citizens of Conway, and

WHEREAS, cable television is a utility service similar in nature to the electric system owned by the City of Conway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

THAT the Conway Corporation is herewith requested to conduct a study for the purpose of identifying the following:

1. Capital cost of a cable television system to serve the City of Conway, Arkansas.

2. Assistance available through local educational institutions, including the public schools.

3. Benefits to be derived by the local educational institutions, including the public schools.

4. Benefits to the departments of local government providing police and fire protection.

5. Benefits of cable television to the subscribers and to the city government.

Further, draft a franchise and lease agreement between the City of Conway and the Conway Corporation that will provide the capital investment necessary for the construction of the cable television system and provide the maximum benefits to the subscribers and to the City of Conway.

The Conway Corporation is hereby requested to use any available unrestricted funds in the hands of said Conway Corporation and belonging to said City, to pay the cost of the above described study.
