RESOLUTION NO. R-80-7

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION REFERRING CONWAY CITY ORDINANCES NO2-80-3 AND 80-4 to a vote of THE PEOPLE:

WHEREAS, City Ordinances No  $\underline{\rho \cdot 8 \rho \cdot 3}$  and  $\underline{\rho \cdot 8 \rho \cdot 4}$  propose a Public Safety Tax and Privilege Tax to be charged on the persons and other legal entities described therein within the city limits of Conway, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, Conway City Ordinances No  $\rho_{4\ell-3}$  and  $\rho_{-4\ell-4}$  further contemplate that the public safety tax or privilege tax therein, and not both, shall take effect only after approval by the voters of the City of Conway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. That a special election is hereby called to be held on March

25, 1980 for the purpose of proposing Conway City Ordinances No  $\rho - \frac{10}{3}$  and  $\rho - \frac{10}{3}$  and  $\rho - \frac{10}{3}$  to a vote of the people of the City of Conway.

Section 2. That the special election herein called shall be for the purpose of obtaining a for or against vote on each ordinance on a ballot entitled "An Ordinance Establishing a Public Safety Tax, the Proceeds of Which are Designated for the Operation of the Police Department and the Fire Department; or, An Ordinance Establishing a Privilege Tax, within the City of Conway."

Section 3. That the ordinance receiving the largest total number of "for" votes and which is enacted by the vote of the people shall be the ordinance enacted by said vote.

Section 4. That the City Council of the City of Conway does hereby respectfully request the Faulkner County Election Commission to conduct the election called for herein in accordance with the laws of the State of Arkansas.

Section 5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
