RESOLUTION NO. R93-21

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS
OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS
TO UTILIZE FEDERAL-AID MONIES

TO INSTALL TRAFFIC SIGNALIZATION AND MAKE OTHER IMPROVEMENTS
AT THE INTERSECTION OF HIGHWAY 60 AND FARRIS ROAD

WHEREAS, the City of Conway understands Federal-Aid Surface
Transportation Program funds are available for certain city projects at the
following Federal participating ratios:

	<u>Work Phase</u>	<u>Federal Share</u>	<u>City Match</u>
1. Traffic Signals	CONSTRUCTION & ENGINEERING	100%	-0-
2. Intersection Improvements	CONSTRUCTION & ENGINEERING RIGHT-OF-WAY & UTILITIES	100% 80%	-0- 20%
3. Roadway & Br. Construction on City Streets	ALL PHASES	80%	20%
4. City projects programmed but not let to contract	ALL PHASES	-0-	100%

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY,
ARKANSAS, THAT:

SECTION I: The City of Conway will participate in accordance with its
designated responsibility in this project.

SECTION II: The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute all
appropriate agreements and contracts necessary to expedite the construction of
the improvements on city streets.

SECTION III: The City of Conway pledges its full support and hereby authorizes
the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department to initiate action
to construct this city project.
