**At its meeting the Conway City Council took the following actions:**

**Ordinances Passed:**

- Ordinance {O-08-70} decreasing rates for premium broadband service for Conway Corporation. **Vote 7-0 w/ Alderman Grimes not present.**
- Ordinance {O-08-71} fixing the rates to be charged for the services of the municipal waterworks system. **Vote 7-0**
- Ordinance {O-08-72} appropriating restitution funds in the amount of \$50.00 and accepting asset forfeiture funds in the amount of \$10,166.91 received from January – May 2008 from the Prosecuting Attorneys Office for the Conway Police Department. **Vote 7-0**
- Ordinance {O-08-73} approving the property transfer of certain items to the Faulkner County Sheriff's Office & Wescon Fire Department. **Vote 7-0**
- Ordinance {O-08-74} appropriating funds in the amount of \$38,257 for two (2) CDL positions for the Conway Sanitation Department. **Vote 7-0**
