Dear Mayor Townsell:

Bids were received at 10:00 AM, Thursday August 20, 2015 at Conway City Hall for the above referenced project. The project involves the construction of 6,560 feet of 5-Strand Barbed Wire Fence along the western side of Sand Gap Road (between Sand Gap Road and the Levee) generally along the limits of the New Cantrell Field. This fence was removed when Sand Gap Road was reconstructed in 2012. At that time the plan was for city forces to reconstruct the fence during the winter months. No time has been available for this work to date. The fence is needed to keep ATV and four wheel drive vehicles from rutting the levee as well as maintain the property owner's cattle within his property. The three bids received are summarized below.

Bill's Fence Company, Inc.	\$28,324
United Fence & Construction Co., Inc.	\$36,042
Flagstone General Contractors, Inc.	\$39,960

I recommend that this project be awarded to the low bidder, Bill's Fence Company, Inc. of Cabot, Arkansas in the amount of \$28,324.

Funding for this project could come from the Pay as You Go Sales Tax (That fund was used to build Sand Gap Road).
