Dear Committee:

The City of Conway is requesting assistance from the State Aid Street Committee to improve the following city street in Conway:

Priority Street NameLengthImprovement1.Tyler Street – County Club to Eve Lane1.7 mileOverlay

Economic Development, Public Access, or other purpose: Portions of the asphalt pavement along this section of Tyler is showing signs of deterioration and will likely lose pavement integrity soon if left unaddressed. Tyler Street is one of four major arterial routes accommodating the east — west movement of traffic in Conway with an average daily traffic volume of approximately 7,000 vehicles per day. This street serves as one of the major routes to three public schools in Conway and also serves as one of the major routes to and from the employment areas. Improving this street would avoid imminent street failures and subsequent reduction in emergency response times and travel time due to deteriorated road conditions and also enhance the area around our community center.

The City is undertaking the improvement of the eastern section of this arterial route and is programing work to rehab failed section on the western end of this route. Improvements to this street is a high priority for the City. Any assistance will be greatly appreciated.
