

ORDINANCE NO. A-366

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6-B OF ORDINANCE NO. A-285 OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION ONE (1). Section 6-b of Ordinance No. A-285, adopted by the City Council of the City of Conway, Arkansas on December 11, 1953, is hereby amended to read as follows;

"SECTION 6-B. Before any opening is made in the pavement of any street or in any unpaved street of the City of Conway, the person desiring to make the opening shall file with the City Inspector of the City of Conway, his, their or its application for a permit to make such opening and shall deposit with said inspector the following sum or sums:

For each opening in any paved streets, such applicant shall deposit the sum of \$1.50 per square foot of the opening made or to be made;

For each opening in any unpaved street, such applicant shall deposit the sum of \$1.00 per square foot of the opening made or to be made;

In the event the sum so deposited shall be found to be less than that required for the opening so made in any street, the person, firm or corporation applying for such permit shall, immediately upon notification of such deficiency, pay to the City Inspector the amount of such deficiency. And in the event such deposit shall exceed that sum required for the opening so made, computed as hereinabove set forth, said inspector shall refund such excess to the person, firm or corporation who paid the same.

Upon the filing of such application and issuance of said permit the City Inspector shall notify the proper officials of the City of Conway and the City shall make such opening and shall refill the same and shall make all repairs necessitated by such opening. It is the intention of the City Council in adopting this ordinance that no person, firm or corporation other than the City of Conway or its designated agents, servants or employees shall make or attempt to

make any street opening or to repair any street opening, or attempt to do so."

SECTION TWO (2). This ordinance being necessary for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the Citizens of the City of Conway, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
