ORDINANCE 0-77-25

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9.04.05 OF THE CONWAY MUNICIPAL CODE: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

That from and after the passage and publication of the above styled ordinance, Section 9.04.05 of the Conway Municipal Code, be amended as follows:

SECTION 1: That the requirements for the thickness of the Portland Cement Concrete on residential streets 4,000# or less to be 6 inches thick, Portland cement concrete for residential feeder streets 6,000# or less is to be 6 inches, Portland cement concrete thickness for commercial route streets 8,000# or less is to be 7 inches thick.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that from and after the passage of this ordiance , that all streets are to contain $5\frac{1}{2}$ sack mix per yard.

SECTION 2: That there shall be no traffic allowed to pass through or upon the said streets within 14 days after said street has been poured.

THIS ORDINANCE, being necessary for the public safety and welfare, an emergency is hereby delcared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
