

ORDINANCE NO. 0-79-6

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR TEN MINUTE PARKING IN DESIGNATED AREA;
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The portion of Locust Street on the East side of said street directly in front of the Southwestern Bell Telephone Company Office Building is hereby declared a ten (10) minute parking zone without meters and is hereby divided into four such parking spaces. It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle therein for longer than ten (10) minutes.

SECTION 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a violation and shall be penalized in accordance with section 8.12.14 of this Code as for other parking violations.

SECTION 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Due to the congested condition of vehicular traffic in the area, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance being necessary for preservation of public peace, health, and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
