

ORDINANCE NO. 0-90- 19

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE METHOD BY WHICH ALDERMEN ARE ELECTED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Conway desires to address the election of aldermen; and

WHEREAS, the redistricting of Wards within the City and the results of the 1990 Census will facilitate an equal distribution of the population within each ward; and

WHEREAS, the most equitable method of election of aldermen is of the utmost importance to the citizens of Conway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. Of the two (2) aldermen elected to serve each Ward, one shall be elected at-large and one shall be elected by-ward.

Section 2. Of each Ward, the Position 2 Alderman shall be elected at-large and the Position 1 Alderman shall be elected by-ward.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the 1st day of January, 1993.
