ORDINANCE NO. 0-90-32

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF VACATING A PORTION OF SPRUCE STREET BETWEEN MARKHAM STREET AND HARRISON STREET DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the City of Conway, Arkansas, upon the opening of Markham Street and Siebenmorgan Road releases, vacates and abandons all its rights, together with the rights of the public generally, in and to that portion of the street designated as follows:

That portion of Spruce Street running between Markham Streets and Harrison Street.

- SECTION 2: That all ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of the conflict except all utilities are hereby reserved and preserved.
- SECTION 3: That this ordinance is necessary for the protection of the public peace, health and safety, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
