

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 1995 CITY OF CONWAY BUDGET; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Conway has submitted to the City Council various amendments to the 1995 budget; and

WHEREAS, the amendments reflect transfers and appropriations for the various departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The sum of \$279,301.90 is hereby transferred from account 51-106-900 and the sum of \$942,133.08 is hereby appropriated to the departments as follows: \$7,115 to the Council budget, \$715,522 to Non-departmental, \$34,031 to the Planning budget, \$19,458.94 to the Maintenance budget, \$31,578.06 to the Municipal Court budget, \$94,751.66 to the Fire budget, \$260,016.52 to the Sanitation budget, \$48,961.80 to the Parks and Recreation budget, and \$10,000 to Other Agencies.

SECTION 2. The sum of \$165,142.28 is hereby appropriated from Unappropriated Street Fund Reserves to the Street Department budget.

SECTION 3. The sum of \$1,233,591.55 is hereby appropriated to the Police Budget to reimburse the Bond Fund for radio equipment purchased from Motorola.

SECTION 4. The Mayor is directed to cause the proper accounting entries to be made in the books and records of the City to reflect these admendments.

SECTION 5. That all ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 6. That this ordinance is necessary for the protection of the public peace, health and safety and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
