

RESOLUTION NO. 74- 22

WHEREAS, The City of Conway, Arkansas has heretofore acquired certain real property from the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company pursuant to a contract wherein the City agreed, among other things, to continue Main Street from Front Street westwardly to Parkway Street and to install fully automatic signals at the crossing of said street over the tracks of said Railroad Company; and

WHEREAS, The electors of said City have failed to adopt an initiated ordinance which sought to retain the depot situated upon said real property and within the proposed right-of-way of Main Street across said lands:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

That the Mayor of the City of Conway is hereby requested and authorized ~~to immediately~~ the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company depot to be torn down and removed from the lands acquired from or through the said railroad company, and to proceed to construct the continuation of Main Street from Front Street to Parkway Street, in accordance with the aforesaid contract.
