"BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Conway,
Arkansas, that WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Conway,
Arkansas, has been informed that Conway Development Corporation
has petitioned or will petition the County Court of Faulkner
County, Arkansas, for annexation into the City of Conway, Arkansas,
of the following described lands in Faulkner County, Arkansas:

The East 1/2 NW 1/4 and the West 1/2 NE 1/4 of Section 20, Township 5 North, Range 13 West, less and except the following described parcel: A part of the East 1/2 NW 1/4 of said Section 20, described as beginning at the southwest corner of said East 1/2 NW 1/4, and running thence north 2 degrees 9 minutes east along the west line of said East 1/2 NW 1/4 a distance of 769.7 feet to a point on the easterly right-of-way line of Interstate Highway 40; thence south 13 degrees 4 minutes east along said easterly right-of-way line a distance of 704.3 feet; thence south 57 degrees 10 minutes east along said right-of-way line a distance of 119.2 feet; thence south 2 degrees 17 minutes 40 seconds west along said right-of-way a distance of 30 feet, to a point on the south line of said NW 1/4 of said Section 20; thence north 87 degrees 42 minutes 20 seconds west along said south line a distance of 287.4 feet to the point of beginning, said exception containing 1.97 acres, more or less, and leaving 158.03 acres, more or less.
