RESOLUTION NO. R-80-23

WHEREAS, there has been and continues to be a dangerous situation at the intersection of Donaghey Avenue and Arkansas State Highway 286, and

WHEREAS, within the last week there has been at least three accidents with one known fatality, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor, Conway City Council, Police Chief are aware of this dangerous situation and of the need for immediate action to prevent further loss of life and property at this intersection,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

THAT the Arkansas Department of Highways and Transportation be requested to lower the speed limit on Highway 286 from the intersection of Highway 365 and Highway 286 extending 500 feet to the west of the Donaghey Avenue and Highway 286 intersection.

ALSO, that the Highway and Transportation Department install at the intersection a flashing yellow caution light for east and west bound traffic on Highway 286 and a flashing red signal for the north and south bound traffic on Donaghey Avenue.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT it be requested that the Highway and Transportation Department undertake an immediate study to determine if further safety and signalization devices are needed at this intersection so that the intersection can be made as safe as feasibly possible for the users of the highway and city street and the residents whose property adjoins said streets.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Mayor and City Clerk are directed to communicate this resolution to the aforementioned parties with appropriate, reports from city officials.
