

RESOLUTION NO. R-82-5

WHEREAS, there is a need in the City of Conway and in surrounding areas for dependable and reasonably priced emergency medical care and ambulance service; and,

WHEREAS, the emergency medical care and ambulance service presently being provided for the citizens of the City of Conway is priced so high that it is a great economic burden for many of these citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Conway and the Conway Memorial Hospital have arrived at an agreement whereby the Conway Memorial Hospital will provide ambulance service at a more reasonable and affordable cost to the citizens of the City of Conway, Arkansas, under a franchise agreement and in accordance with the ordinances of said City; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Conway, Arkansas, have found this franchise agreement to be in the public interest, and have found said agreement necessary for the preservation of the public health, welfare, and safety of the inhabitants of the City,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS: the City of Conway, Arkansas, a Municipal Corporation, organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Arkansas and located in the County of Faulkner therein, in consideration of the agreement by the Conway Memorial Hospital to provide ambulance service to the inhabitants of said city, which agreement is being concurrently executed with this resolution, hereby bargains, grants, and conveys to the Conway Memorial Hospital, for providing an ambulance service the sum of \$75,000 Dollars.


This grant is made upon the express condition that the sum granted hereby shall be used for the purchase of emergency medical equipment and ambulances, the erection of an ambulance shelter for the housing of said vehicles and equipment, and for the purchase of communication equipment necessary to the functioning of said ambulance service, and for other necessary and incidental expenses to the providing of said ambulance service, and for no other purposes whatsoever, and

should said property or any portion thereof be used for any other purpose, then, in that event, the property hereby granted shall immediately revert unto said City, its successors or assigns.


This grant is made on the express condition that all covenants in the franchise agreement referred to above and dated on the 2nd day of February , 1982, between City of Conway and the Conway Memorial Hospital shall be applicable hereto, and said agreement is incorporated herein by reference as well as all conditions required by the ordinances of the City of Conway, Laws of the State of Arkansas applicable to ambulance service, and all Laws of the United States applicable thereto.

The Mayor and the City Clerk of the City of Conway, Arkansas, are hereby authorized and directed to cause said sum to be appropriated from moneys designated in the budget document for the year of 1982 for said purpose.
