

RESOLUTION NO. R-85-5

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS OF THE CITY OF CONWAY TO MATCH FEDERAL AID URBAN MONIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF RESIGNALIZATION:

WHEREAS, the City of Conway understands additional Federal-Aid Urban System funds are available for traffic control signalization on city streets at 100% Federal participation; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the top priority signalization project is the signalization of Hwy 64/286 and Hwy 65B/6th Street; and

WHEREAS, the City understands that, when applicable, their matching portion of this project will be 25% of the total cost of appraisal and acquisition of right-of-way, relocation services, and adjustment of man-made improvements, including utilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS, THAT:


SECTION 1. The City of Conway will participate in accordance with its designated responsibility in this project.

SECTION 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute all appropriate agreements and contracts necessary to expedite the construction of the improvements on city streets.

SECTION 3. The City of Conway pledges its full support and hereby authorizes the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department to initiate action to construct this project.
