RESOLUTION NO. R-86-23


WHEREAS, a Petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Conway, Arkansas, to abandon and vacate a street right-of-way for an unopened street designated as Railroad Avenue running between College Avenue and McKay Avenue in Daviess and Garvin's Annex to the City of Conway, Arkansas, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

A street right-of-way 50' in width running North and South from College Avenue to McKay Avenue and abutting Lots 2-15, Block 9, Daviess and Garvin's Annex to the City of Conway and the Missouri Pacific Railroad right-of-way, all within the City of Conway, Faulkner County, Arkansas.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:
