RESOLUTION NO. R-01-21

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE INTENT OF THE CONWAY CITY COUNCIL TO PURSUE FUNDING OF A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF PUBLIC TRANSIT. IN CONWAY

WHEREAS, the Conway City Council considers public transit to be beneficial to the citizens of Conway in providing an alternate method of traveling from point to point in the city and alleviating traffic congestion, and

WHEREAS the Conway City Council is desirous of providing public transit to the citizens of Conway, and

WHEREAS the council considers public transit to be of such benefit and importance that it would, if necessary, be willing to allocate a portion of the 30 percent funds received through the Central Arkansas Regional Transportation Study.

NOW **THEREFORE** BE **IT RESOLVED** BY **THE CITY COUNCIL** OF **THE CITY** OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS **THAT**:

Section 1: The City of Conway shall take the necessary steps to initiate a transit study for the city, including, but not limited to, identifying finding sources and advertising for a consultant, provided the Council approved the budget for the study prior to bidding.

Section 2: Such a study is to ascertain if public transit is feasible in Conway, and if so, the area to be covered by the transit system, the type of transit system to be put in place, feasible methods of funding the operation of such a system and offering alternative operators of such a system.
