Resolution No. R-19-46

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS OF THE CITY OF CONWAY TO UTILIZE FEDERAL-AID MONIES FOR THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL UPGRADE AT THE INTERSECTION OF HIGHWAY 65B AND ROBINS STREET; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Whereas, the City of Conway understands Federal-aid Surface Transportation Block Grant Program funds are available for certain local projects at the following Federal, State, and City participating rations up to a maximum of \$350,000 Federal-aid available per project:

Traffic Signals/Intersection Improvements – Construction & Engineering: Federal Share 80%, State Share 10%, City Share 10%. The City share for this work phase will be 10% unless the overall cost of this phase exceeds \$437,500. If this occurs, 100% of the amount above this value will be the responsibility of the City.

Right-of-Way and Utilities – City Share 100%

Projects designed but never progressed to construction, All Phases – City Share 100%; and

Whereas, the Arkansas Department of Transportation has agreed to this arrangement and will provide funding for 10% of the project costs up to \$43,750 and will handle all phases of the project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Conway, Arkansas that:


Section 1: The City will participate in accordance with its designated responsibility in this project, which includes providing electrical service, maintenance of the traffic signal and associated control equipment, and 100% of any costs over the maximum available funds (\$350,000 Federal-aid and \$43,750 State).

Section 2: The Mayor, or their designated representative, is hereby authorized and directed to execute all appropriate agreements and contracts necessary to expedite the construction of this project.

Section 3: The City pledges its full support and hereby authorizes the Arkansas Department of Transportation to initiate action to implement this project.
