WHEREAS, the MPO is charged with the responsibility of developing and administering Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Central Arkansas Regional Transportation Study; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Improvement Program includes a group funding category for CARTS Various Attrib Projects (Surface Transportation Program and Highway Infrastructure Program); and

WHEREAS, project applications were received August 26, 2020; and


WHEREAS, projects were evaluated in accordance with the policies and at the direction of the Metroplan Board;


