SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM AND HIGHWAY INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Metroplan is the officially designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Little Rock-North Little Rock-Conway metropolitan area; and

WHEREAS, the MPO is charged with the responsibility of developing and administering Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Central Arkansas Regional Transportation Study; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Improvement Program includes a group funding category for CARTS Various Attrib Projects (Surface Transportation Program and Highway Infrastructure Program); and

WHEREAS, project applications were received January 7, 2020; and

WHEREAS, projects were evaluated in accordance with the policies and at the direction of the Metroplan Board;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that as the metropolitan planning organization for central Arkansas, the Metroplan Board of Directors allocates regional funding to the following projects for obligation in federal fiscal year 2020;


